








#### Pendo dot-to-dot

Simply join the dots to reveal one of our Pendolino trains – they're the high-speed, electric tilting ones by the way.








#### Roll out the dream machine

Stripes? Spots? Rainbow-coloured? Let your imagination run wild – design a livery of your own.


('Livery', pronounced liv-uh-ree, is the name for a train's 'coat' – the decoration on the outside of the coaches.)




# Pendolino colouring-ino







## Spot the difference



Step: 7


Check the platform one last time Step: 8

Choo-choo! Your train is on the move!





