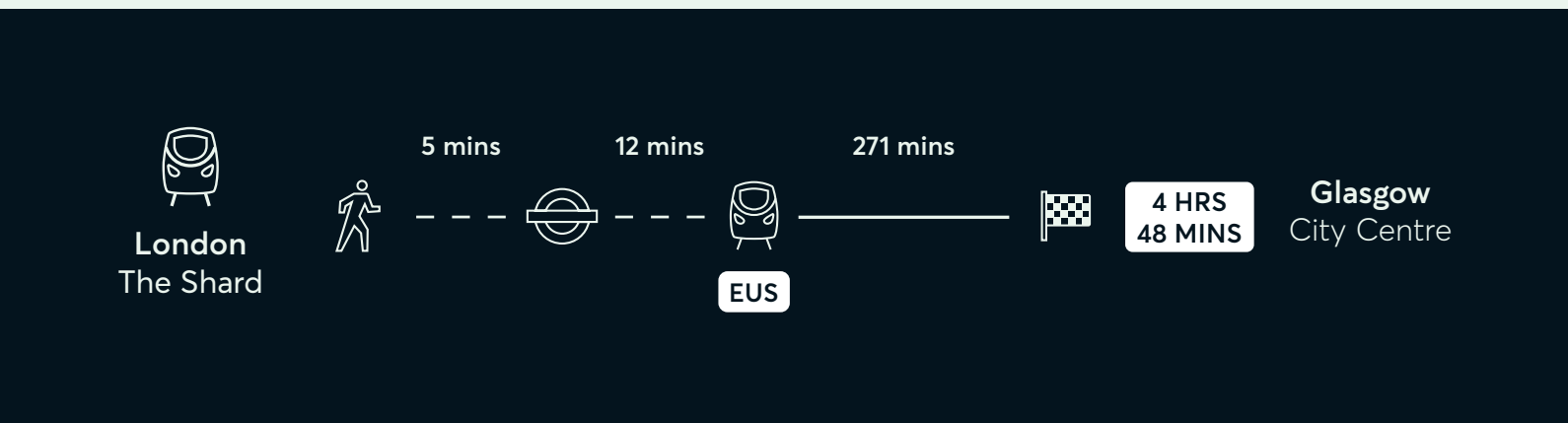
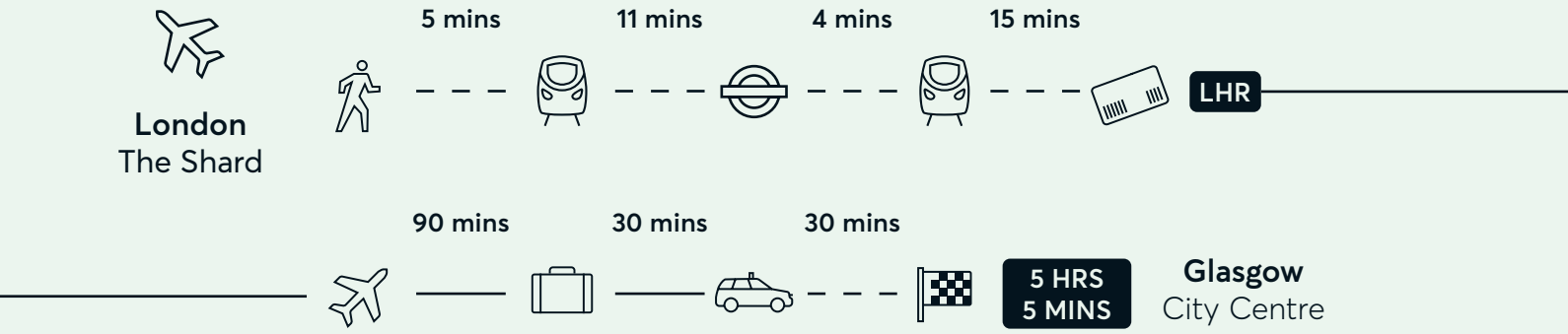


London to Glasgow by plane or train?

Carbon Footprint

Plane from Heathrow Airport

20% of your travel time connected and whole 80% of your travel time stuck in flight mode.

140.4 gCO₂e/KM That's quite the carbon footprint for one journey from Heathrow to Glasgow.

Train from London Euston

90% of your travel time can be spent connected, passing the minutes however you please.

26.3 gCO₂e/KM Our trains are a much more sustainable mode of transport and we mean green.
