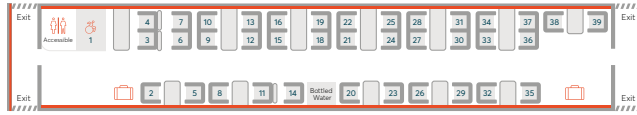

Wheelchair User Spaces	First Class: 1 Located in coach J Standard Class: 2 Located in coach B and D
Mobility Scooter Carriage	Mobility scooters up to 70cm wide and 120cm long with a combined weight of scooter and user of less than 300Kg can be take on any [FTI] service. Customers must transfer out of their scooter into a seat when on board the train.
On Board Ramps	Yes Located in coach vestibules adjacent to wheelchair user spaces
Passenger Info System	Yes Audio/Visual announcements with digital customer information screens
Priority Seats	Yes 53 standard class 18 first class
Contrasting grab rails	Yes
Staff	All Pendolino trains operate with staff on board who are able to provide assistance to customers.

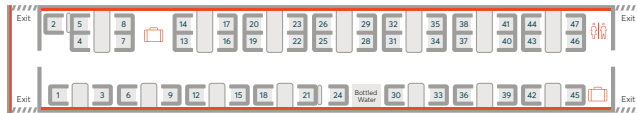

Accessible Toilets	Yes Accessible toilet in coach A and E (also L and G when double trains operate) next to the wheelchair user spaces, equipped with baby changing facilities
Standard Toilets	Yes Standard toilet in coach B, C, H and J
Wheelchair User Spaces	First Class: 1 Located in coach E (and coach L when double trains operate) Standard Class: 2 Located in coach A (and coach G when double trains operate)
Mobility Scooter Carriage	Mobility scooters up to 70cm wide and 120cm long with a combined weight of scooter and user of less than 300Kg can be take on any [FTI] service. Customers must transfer out of their scooter into a seat when on board the train.
On Board Ramps	Yes Located in coach vestibules adjacent to wheelchair user spaces
Passenger Info System	Yes Audio/Visual announcements with digital customer information screens
Priority Seats	Yes 25 standard class (per 5 coach train) 3 first class (per 5 coach train)
Contrasting grab rails	Yes
